I. FUTURE TENSES

I.1. Future simple continuous tense

I.1.1. Usage

The future simple continuous tense can be used to express an ongoing action in the future by using "will be" and "be going to be". It's also used to show the short action in the future which is happening during or while a longer action is in progress in the future. Indeed, the word "when" can be used to show when the short actions occurs.

I.1.1. Affirmative form (Different usages)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ongoing action that will happen in the future by using "<u>will be</u>" and "<u>be going to be</u>" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I <u>will be taking</u> the test <u>soon</u>. - I'm <u>going to be taking</u> the test <u>soon</u>. - He <u>will be sleeping</u> by <u>10 p.m.</u> - He's <u>going to be sleeping</u> by <u>10 p.m.</u> - They <u>will be studying</u> <u>next October</u>. - They're <u>going to be studying</u> <u>next October</u>.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Action in the future which is happening during or while a longer action is in progress in the future by using "<u>when</u>" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I <u>will be sleeping</u> <u>when</u> they <u>arrive</u>. (after when, we must use the P.S) - we <u>will be having</u> dinner <u>when</u> the movie <u>starts</u>. - Tina <u>is going to be working</u> <u>when</u> you <u>leave</u>. - It <u>will be raining</u> <u>when</u> you <u>go</u> shopping.

I.1.2. Negative form (By using : "will not be" or "won't be" / "be not going to be")
